## TENNIS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Only paid up members of are permitted on the courts (except where Green Fees are paid by non members).
- Dress code Nothing too outlandish. Proper trainers/tennis shoes must be worn for the sake of the courts. Shirts must be worn at all times and no football/rugby shirts please.
- Do not enter any court, or collect or ask for balls from neighbouring courts until the rally has finished.
- Return tennis balls to adjoining courts as soon as play stop.
- Only call the lines on your side of the net.
- If there is any doubt between partners, a let should be played. Should you have serious doubts about your opponents or partners eye-sight, ask politely if they are certain about the accuracy of their call. If they are, accept it and get on with next point.
- Enter and leave your court through the nearest gate. Should you pass a court to get to a gate, make sure the ball is not in play.
- The use of foul language, abusive outbursts and intimidating behaviour to any member will not be tolerated.
- Men should be considerate in mixed doubles towards women especially when serving or playing to women when at the net.
- No mobile phones, water glasses or glass bottles are allowed on the courts.
- Show respect and courtesy.
